- One sponsor has bought a piglet for her sponsored boy. The family can feed the piglet by getting scraps from neighbours, teashops and restaurants, to feed it, and when the pig gets big enough they can sell it. It is a great way to help a family, as they can buy another piglet with the money, plus have some savings.
- More clothes were sent from Denmark from Kirstina Khunel, and included in the parcel, were new shoes donated by a shoe manufacturer. Kirstina sends clothes by post generally once a month.
